 - The grief and loss program is for women who have experienced loss. We ask that women wait six months after a loss has occurred before participating in the program. The program provides an opportunity to explore grief and loss issues within a confidential, supportive environment. We assist women in developing healthy ways to deal with emotions that accompany the grief process.
 - The grief and loss program is a ten week closed group, which runs 1-2 times annually. Sessions included: exploring the stages of grieving, honour each other losses, discussion, imagery, sharing, journaling, art therapy.
