

## Palliative Manitoba Board Roles and Responsibilities

Becoming a board member of Palliative Manitoba is a rewarding experience. You will gain knowledge about palliative care in Manitoba; work with those who are passionate about palliative care and be giving back to the community. The expectations of being a board member include:

- Purchasing an annual membership (currently \$50/year)
- Regular attendance at board meetings, which occur approximately 6 times per year, in the early evenings. A board member **may** be removed from the Board of Directors if three (3) consecutive meetings are missed without cause. Additional meetings may be called as needed.
- Supporting and attending Palliative Manitoba events, including but not limited to:
  - Annual Celebrate Life Fundraiser
    - Buying and/or selling tickets; reaching out to your contacts to offer sponsorship opportunities; and/or
    - Volunteering your time to help organize the Fundraiser; or volunteering your time at the Fundraiser
  - Annual Hike for Hospice
    - Collecting pledges for the Hike for Hospice
    - Participating in the Hike for Hospice
  - Annual Food and Wine Pairing event
    - Buying and/or selling tickets to the event
    - Attendance at the event
  - Annual Provincial Palliative Care conference
    - Reaching out to your contacts to offer sponsorship opportunities
    - Promoting the conference
    - Volunteering at the conference
- Being a spokesperson for Palliative Manitoba
- Committing to help Palliative Manitoba achieve its strategic plan
- Committing to participating on a board sub-committee (for example: Executive, Governance, Finance)
