

Palliative Manitoba Statement on Revised Public Health Orders

On Saturday, August 7th, 2021 The Province of Manitoba changed the health order changes. Palliative Manitoba is confirming that at this time:

- 1) There will be no change to the safety measures we are currently taking pertaining to provide compassionate care to the individuals we support.
- 2) We continue to work mainly from home, limiting office access and, encouraging remote or outdoor meetings when possible. If you need to drop anything off, please call ahead and make arrangements in advance.
- 3) As our office is in Deer Lodge Centre, individuals who are attending our office must be screened at the main entrance on Portage Avenue.
- 4) Palliative Manitoba will continue to follow all health and safety requirements, including the wearing of masks that are set forth by Deer Lodge Centre to ensure the health and wellness of everyone and reduce the risk of transmission of COVID-19.

We will continue to review our practices while ensuring we are following the direction and recommendations from both the public health orders and Deer Lodge Centre.
